Monthly Money Matters March 2017

In February, the budget for offerings caught up with the large one-time offerings from January. Year to date (YTD) offerings were still modestly over budget. Meanwhile February was a large expense month as we paid the per capita and the bulk of the Doll's moving expenses. Still expenses were slightly less than the YTD budget. This is due to continued careful spending by the staff and the committee co-chairs.

On the subject of expense control, we have noticed that when some of you miss a week or two you will write multiple checks the following week to "catch up" or you will write a check to the Deacons and another to the operating fund on the same week. If you are doing this for your own recording-keeping purpose, please continue to do so. However, a single check covering multiple weeks of a pledge or a single check for the Deacons and operating fund is easier for staff to record and deposit. Fewer checks are also less expensive for the church. Our bank allows us 500 transactions per month for one basic fee. A transaction is any check we write or any check we deposit. We are charged \$0.40 apiece for all transactions over the monthly allowance. The amounts involved are small but the stewardship of your offerings is important. In the Deacons/ operating fund example, or any other time your check is meant to be split among accounts, be sure to note it on the memo line of the check or on your envelope.

Stewardship Update March 2017

The Stewardship Committee is still happy to receive your Stewardship pledges to the Annual Operating Budget. If you wish to pledge, please complete a white *Get Ready* pledge card located in the Narthex or pew back and leave in the offering plate or drop at the church office.

GVPC took advantage of the 10% discount offered for early payment of our required per capita. As a result, the payment made was \$19,332 instead \$21,480. Thus far, we have received \$10,450 from our church members who paid their per capita portion. Thank you to those who have generously given to cover that cost. As with the stewardship pledges, we continue to welcome you to pay your per capita portion of \$40.00 per member. Please note per capita on the memo line of check.

Resources for Seniors

Meal Options for Seniors

There are numerous options available for seniors who are not able to easily cook for themselves or who really have no desire to do their own cooking. Today, I am just featuring a couple of options, though, there are so many I could write several articles. Two resources available to us that I am featuring in this article are our very own Green Valley Presbyterian Meals Ministry and a delivery service that came highly recommended to me from one of our members called Magic Kitchen. (I am always trying to keep my ears open to suggestions from church members on topics they think that our fellow church family would like to know about.)



Green Valley Presbyterian Church Meals Ministry

For a couple years, church members have been providing meals through the Meals Ministry for those going through challenging times. It began as hot meals but in November we added a new dimension which is frozen meals. Thanks to the generosity of the Deacons, we purchased a small freezer which is located in the kitchen. We have a committee of about a dozen ladies who contribute food to the freezer. Special thanks to Heather Booker who kicked off our frozen meals by contributing food to the freezer every week for a number of months. Many weeks we may not have any requests for food but other weeks, we have provided frozen food for 2-3 families at a time. Magic Kitchen

As our Meals Ministry cannot really cater to special diets, I have been hearing outstanding recommendations from a member of the congregation who has found that Magic Kitchen meets the needs for her family. Magic Kitchen provides healthy, chef prepared meals across the USA. Customers can order meals meeting the needs for all sorts of special diets including low sodium, diabetic-friendly, low carbohydrate, low fat, renal diet, dialysis-friendly, gluten-free, portion control and diets especially prepared for seniors. Complete meals can be ordered or items can be ordered a la carte. Several healthy meal plans are available. Complete meals average about \$12 a piece and shipping typically begins at \$18-\$20 depending on what is ordered. Further information can be found at magickitchen.com.



The Session meeting was held on Tuesday, February 28th, 2017 with Pastor Adrian Doll moderating his first meeting at GVPC. The committees gave their reports with the following committees submitting action items for approval.

<u>Personnel</u> – to add the last Monday in May as a paid holiday for Memorial Day, removing Good Friday as a paid holiday and adding the Monday following Easter Sunday as a paid holiday.

<u>Fellowship</u> – to approve a Line Dancing/Chili Cook-Off Event at GVPC on October 28th, 2017.

<u>Membership</u> – to approve spending up to \$650.00 for sticker ads (advertising Easter services) that will placed on the Las Vegas Review Journal within five chosen zip codes.

<u>Worship & Music</u> – to approve the Azusa Pacific Concert on Monday, May 8th, 2017 and to house 130 students. Missions – to approve the quarterly and monthly disbursements for the year 2017 to our mission projects.

<u>Administration</u> – the 2016 Financial Review has been completed and a motion was made to enter it as being received and approved by Session.

All the above motions were approved.

<u>Clerk of Session</u> – Member Joyce Carey passed away on January 10th, 2017. She had been a member since November 3rd, 1996. Members John Ashlock and Dottie Henshaw were married on February 18th, 2017 at Green Valley Presbyterian Church. On February 26th, 2017 Betsy Johnson was ordained as Deacon to Class of 2017 and Doug Small was installed as Elder to the Class of 2018.

The church statistical report for 2016 was presented and sent to the General Assembly. A motion was made to request the removal from active membership, Barbara Mear, at her request on January 27th, 2017. The motion was seconded and carried. The Nevada Presbytery meeting was held at Henderson Presbyterian Church the first week in March. Some highlights for our church – Pastor Adrian Doll's call as Pastor Of Green Valley Presbyterian Church was approved and he was enthusiastically received as a member of the Presbytery of Nevada. His Service of Installation will be on Sunday April 23rd, 2017 at 10:00 A.M. The Special Offering received at the worship service was designated for the Presbyterian Disaster Assistance Youth Mission Trip to Baton Rouge, LA, this summer to assist victims of flooding.
